These nurseries offer a 10% discount on plants purchased for the competition. Simply show your registration form to receive this discount.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Entries must be in the hanging basket and liner supplied for fairness and consistency. No other basket or liner combination will be eligible;
- · Plants must be living and growing in the potting mix and the basket must contain at least one plant;
- There are no restrictions on the plants used, but they must not be a declared noxious weed;
- Entries that have visible signs of disease or pest may be refused entry;
- Accessories may be used but must be complimentary to the basket design. We recommend keeping these to a minimum;
- · Event Organisers reserves the right to remove any exhibit without notice or reason;
- · Baileys Fertilisers has the right to receive all competition participant data for marketing use;

- Competition closes on Monday the 1st of April 2019.

DELIVERY OF ENTRIES:

- Entries must be delivered on Wednesday 10th April between 9am 2pm, delivered to McCallum Park, Victoria Park. A map outlining the drop off location will be sent out prior to the event.
- · It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure their entry is received within this time frame;
- The baskets will be cared for during the show on the basis of all care and no responsibility;
- Event Organisers will take all reasonable steps to maintain the exhibits in as good a condition as possible however the display is open to all elements and is not under shelter (ie direct sun and or direct rain)
- The baskets will remain on display for the duration of the show;
- No entry may be removed from the site without the permission of CSA or their appointed representative.

COLLECTION OF ENTRIES:

- Entries are to be collected from the competition site at the conclusion of the show. They can be collected on Sunday the 14th between 4pm-5pm or Monday the 15th of April 2019 between 10am-3pm:
- Baskets not collected by 3pm on Monday the 15th of April 2019 will be donated;
- If you do not wish to collect your hanging basket please let Event Organisers know and it will be donated to a loving home.
